

WHAT IS DU'AA?

Du'aa literally means to call. In essence, it is an intimate call between us and Allaah ﷺ. We ask, complain, beg and confide in the One who will always hear us, listen to us and respond to us – Allaah ﷺ. We can ask for whatever we like, as long as it is good and Halal for us. Whether we complain to Allaah ﷺ or we request from Him, we are rewarded, because it is an act of worship.

The Prophet ﷺ said, 'Du'aa is worship itself. Then the Prophet ﷺ recited this verse, 'Your Lord says, "Call upon Me and I will respond to you...."'

[Tirmidhi] [Surah Ghaafir]

WHY IS DU'AA IMPORTANT?

Du'aa is for us. It is not for Allaah ﷺ. The weak and helpless moments that we experience as humans, require us to call out and seek help. When we are struggling with emotions, hardship and confusion, Allaah ﷺ is ever near. We need Du'aa to keep our restless hearts at ease and keep us connected to our Creator.

The Messenger ﷺ of Allaah ﷺ said, 'When one of you calls upon Allaah ﷺ, let him hope for the greatest of things. Verily, nothing has any greatness over Allaah ﷺ.'

[Ibn Hibban]

HOW DO I MAKE DU'AA?

Begin with praising Allaah ﷺ

A man was supplicating in the presence of the Messenger of Allaah ﷺ and said, 'O Allaah ﷺ forgive me and have mercy on me'. The Prophet ﷺ said to him, 'You have been too hasty O' worshipper. When you have prayed and are sitting, praise Allaah (SWT) as He deserves to be praised...'

Send blessings upon the Prophet Muhammad ﷺ

The Prophet ﷺ said, 'Every Du'aa is kept back until you send blessings upon the Prophet ﷺ.'

[Tabarani]

Ask Allaah ﷺ by the most appropriate names

If we want a better salary, who will give it to us? It is Allaah ﷺ, al-Razzaq – the Provider, who will provide for us. If we want good health, who will grant us healing? It is Allaah ﷺ, al-Shaafi – the Healer, who will heal us from our ailments. To use the most appropriate name of Allaah ﷺ in our Du'aa, is important to our Du'aa being answered.

Ask with a dire need of Allaah ﷺ

When gathered on the plains of Arafat the Messenger ﷺ said in his Du'aa, 'I am the desperate and needy one, the one who is seeking your help.'

Make Du'aa in times of prosperity

The Messenger of Allaah ﷺ said, 'Remember Allaah ﷺ during times of ease and He will remember you during times of hardship.' [Musnad]

HOW CAN I PERFECT MY DU'AA?

Avoid committing sin

Stay away from consuming Haram and indulging in sin. The Prophet ﷺ spoke of a man who beseeched Allaah ﷺ. The Prophet ﷺ said, this man is saying 'O' Lord, O' Lord, but his food was unlawful, his drink was unlawful, his clothing was unlawful and he was nourished from that which was unlawful, so how will his Du'aa be accepted?' [Muslim]

Have conviction in your heart

The Prophet ﷺ said, 'Call upon Allaah . with certainty that He (SWT) will answer you. Know that Allaah will not answer the supplication of a heart that is unmindful and distracted.'

[Tirmidhi]

Face the Qiblah and raise the hands

The Prophet ﷺ said, 'Your Lord, may He (SWT) be blessed and exalted, is Kind and Most Generous, and He (SWT) is too kind to let His (SWT) slave, if he raises his hands to Him (SWT), bring them back empty.' [Abu Dawood]

Making Du'aa at the following times

- When fasting
- Between the Adhaan and Iqaamah
- When travelling
- In the last third of the night
- Whilst making Sujood
- The final hour of Friday (before maghrib)
- At the end of the obligatory prayers

DU'AA FOR ENTERING THE MASJID



DU'AA AFTER THE ADHAAN






